# Fun with Search-A-Word Coloring Book

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## Note

A search-a-word puzzle is a large grid, filled with letters, that has words hidden in it. There is one search-a-word puzzle on each of the next 36 pages of this book. Surrounding each grid are pictures of familiar people, animals, and objects, whose names are hidden in the puzzle. The pictured things are easy enough to identify—but before you look for their names, you should be sure that you know how to spell them!

Next to each picture is a row of blank spaces, in which you should spell out the name of the pictured item. (We have filled in the first letter and some other letters of each word, to get you started.) Once you have filled in all the correct letters and have the words in front of you on the page, you are ready to look for them in the puzzle. They will run across or down and sometimes overlap each other. Circle them with a pencil as you find them.

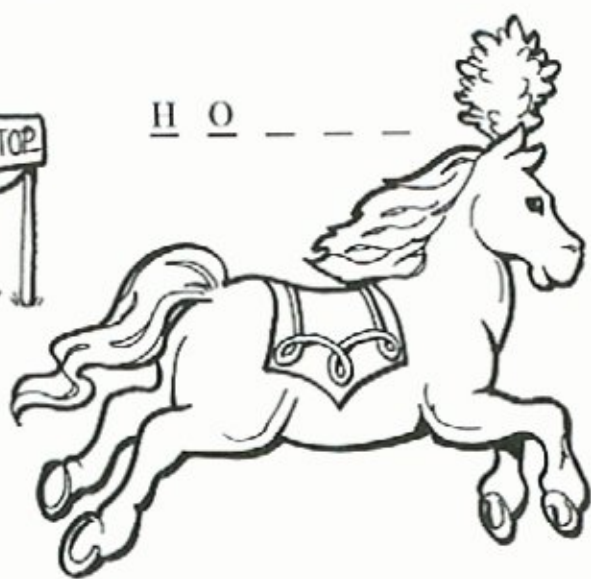
